In a two-artist show at **Locks Gallery**, Joseph Cornell overshadows Thomas Chimes, but don't miss the latter's small fine paintings, including one based on the famous photograph of Marcel Duchamp as Adam, in fig-leaf and wristwatch. **Peter Blum** is showcasing the poignant photographs of everyday life taken by the French avant-garde filmmaker Chris Marker in North Korea in 1957, as the country was sealing itself off from the world.
